The TOChina Summer School, a partnership of the Department of Culture, Politics and Society, University of Torino, the Torino World Affairs Institute, and the Australian Center on China in the World (CIW) has been running with the support of Fondazione CRT since 2007 to help outstanding students, young scholars and engaged professionals reflect on the complexity of China's development and return to global prominence from a plurality of perspectives.

Based at the new "Luigi Einaudi" campus of the University of Torino, the Summer School welcomes participants in a vibrant international environment, where an informal work style allows for free, in-depth discussion on critical issues that lie at the intersection of China's long-term structural transformations and global current affairs.

In 2014 the School will once again feature its trademark **China Room Conversations** conference: its focus will be on China's role and strategies in the West Asia - Northern Africa region. This year's CRC is supported by the Chiang Ching-kuo Foundation and the Wilson Center. UN Special Envoy Romano Prodi will deliver the keynote address.

Applications are accepted from students and professionals from all over the world. Participants are selected through a highly competitive process, strictly based on academic merit, professional achievements and individual potential. Graduate students and young researchers from Europe and Asia make up the bulk of the class every year.

Online applications are accepted as from April 7th 2014.

Students may apply for ZEROTASSE scholarships, waving tuition costs completely. Those who do not live in the Torino area can alternatively apply for the FREETORINO scholarships, covering tuition, accommodation and, partially, meals for the duration of their stay in Torino.
